

Loading Study 1

- Normal noteheads are fingerings held until end of phrase/slur.
 Only tongue the normal noteheads.
- 'Ping' noteheads are 'loading' holes/keys added to the initial fingering.
 e.g. see fingerings examples in first system.
- Loading holes/keys are kept pressed until end of phrase/slur.
- Dynamics should be quiet-ish throughout.
